

SUMMER AT WHAKAPAPA

Experience the volcano in summer for alpine adventures and enviable photo opportunities on a variety of short walks, typically available December - June, Refule with a delicious lunch, coffee or snack from the Knoll Ridge Chalet, perched 2020m above sea level, with breathtaking views of The Tongariro National Park through the floor to ceiling windows.

GETTING HERE

Top of Bruce Road, Mt Ruapehu. Just over an hour south of Taupō in the Central North Island and next door to Tongariro Alpine Crossing. Follow SH48, an easy, sealed 6km drive past Whakapapa Village.



2.5 hrs

Start from the top of Sky Waka Gondola

One for the bucket list! Described as the 'best short walk' in Tongariro National Park, Skyline takes you from the Knoll Ridge Chalet (2,020m) to Skyline Ridge (2,300m) for views of Mt Ngauruhoe, Lake Taupō & beyond.





1.5-2 hrs

Start from the top of Sky Waka gondola

From the Knoll Ridge Chalet (2,020m), walk the same path as ancient lava flows & lahars as you descend past stunning waterfalls, rugged volcanic terrain & amazing views of the Central Plateau.
