

Based on the World Health Organization's classification of undernutrition rates, the stunting prevalence of children in the Philippines is of 'very high' public health significance. The Philippines' 29 percent stunting rate places it fifth among countries in the East Asia and Pacific region, and among the top 10 countries globally. The Philippines' high levels of childhood undernutrition can lead to a staggering loss of the country's human and economic potential. The burden on the Philippines' economy brought by childhood undernutrition was estimated at US\$4.4 billion, or 1.5 percent of the country's GDP, in 2015. Undernutrition robs Filipino children of their chance of...".
