


# Why supply chain transformation needs a process-led approach

Conventional optimization approaches overlook the everyday processes that make up supply chains. It's time to take a process-led approach. Here's why – and what you can do.




# Supply chains face a frenzy of disruption


69% of businesses experienced supply chain disruption from geopolitical events in 2024 (WTW)



Plugging the technology gap has "never been more critical", according to <u>PwC</u>, given regulations surrounding supply chain traceability and nonfinancial reporting.


