Session Cookies are automatically erased when you close your browser; Persistent Cookies, unless deleted, remain on your computer or other device until a set expiration date. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

3. Our Use of Cookies

- 3.1 We use the following categories of cookies:
 - Strictly Necessary Cookies: These are cookies that are required for the
 operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to
 log into secure areas of our Website.
 - Analytical/Performance Cookies: These are cookies that allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
 - **Functionality Cookies:** These are cookies that are used to recognise you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences, for example your choice of language or region.
