In this phase, you will learn the basics of UX and UI and how to visualize ideas using design principles. You will also learn the Design Thinking method, how to set up design workshops, document data, and improve presentation skills.

In phase 3, you'll delve into advanced Figma functions and tools, making designs and concepts responsive, inclusive, and accessible for all users. You'll also establish basic style guides based on brand-guided inspiration.

User testing is a crucial step to ensure that designs meet user needs and can be improved upon. You'll conduct your first usability test, gather data, and gain valuable insights. Additionally, you'll learn about the impact of dark and light patterns in design and the responsibility that designers hold towards people and the environment.

This final project will serve as a testament to your skills and be a key feature of your UX/UI portfolio.
