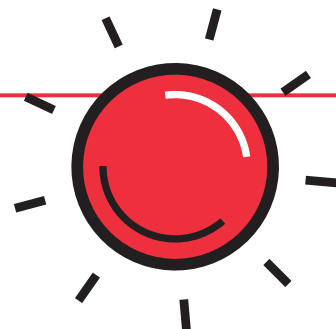

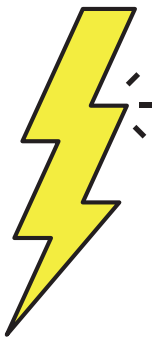

TEACHERS' NOTES & ANSWERS
