There are **six** in total.



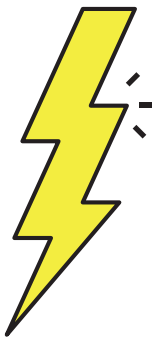

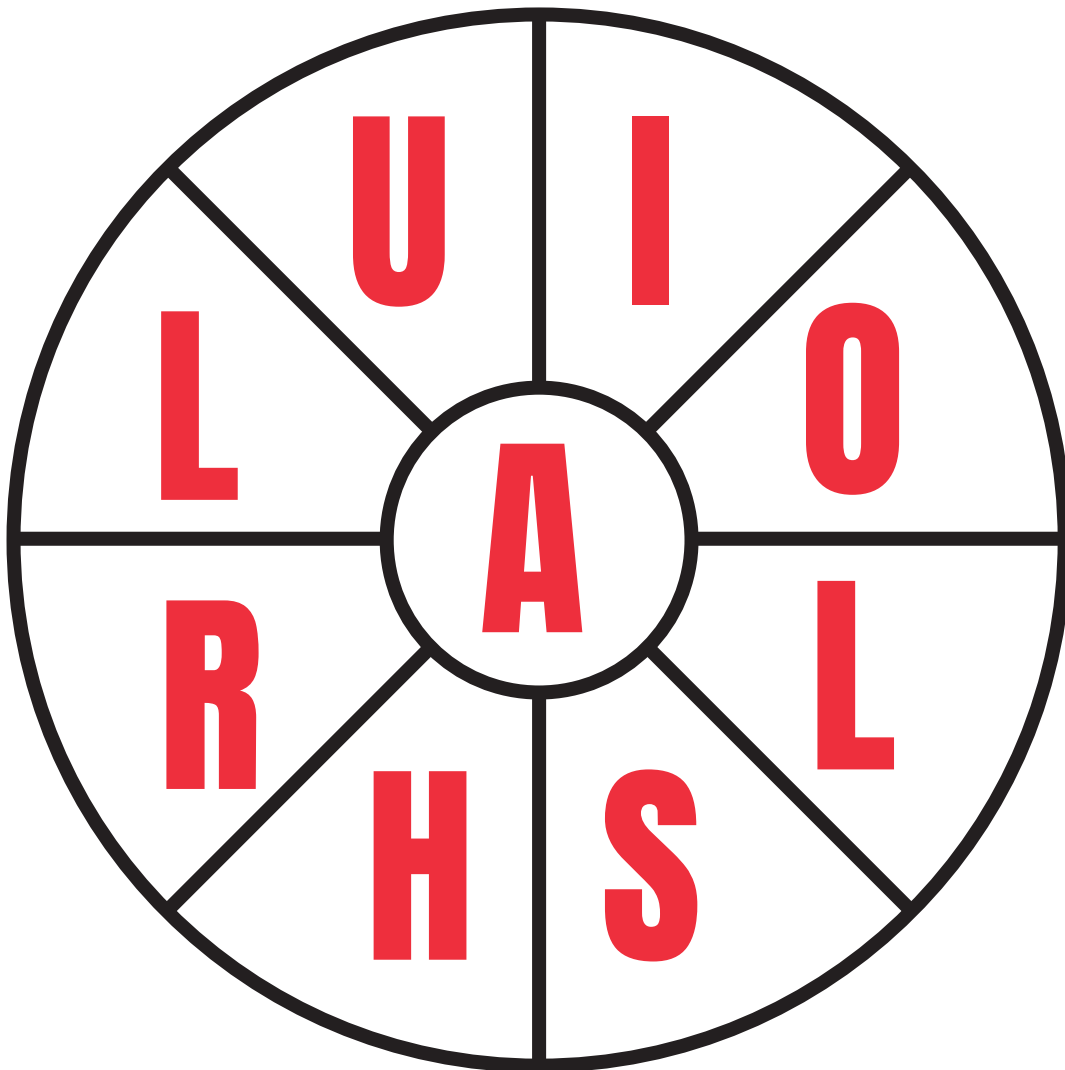
