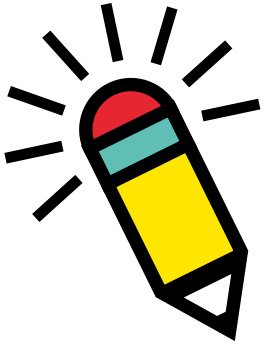


TEACHERS' NOTES & ANSWERS



This Red Nose Day, the power to change the world is in your hands. Our quiz and puzzle pack for secondary schools has been designed as a simple, fun way to raise awareness of the event and encourage students to join in with the fun and make a difference.

In the run-up to Red Nose Day you could use the quiz and puzzles:

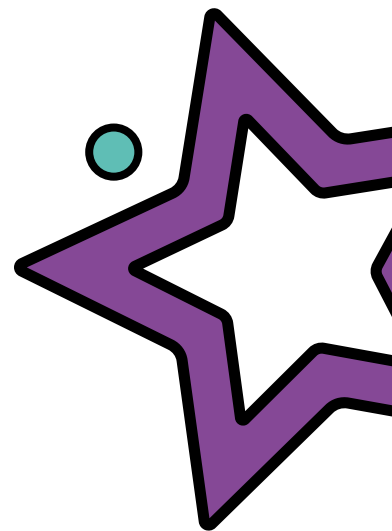
- during tutor time
- as the basis for fun, engaging virtual sessions if students are working from home
- as a fundraiser, asking for donations or a small fee to take part.

There are four separate activities to choose from:

- **Red Nose Day Quiz** – with three rounds focusing on the colour red, noses and riddles. Why not use to put on a big quiz event? See the box below for ideas...
- **Word search** – find the Red Nose Day related words
- **Spot the difference** – can your students spot the eight changes to the picture?
- **Unscrambling words** – how many words can students make from the letters?

If you want to use the activities to raise some cash, ask the students to make a donation or pay a small fee to take part. And don't forget to use the paying-in slip at the back of the pack to pay in any money you raise.

ORGANISING A FUNDRAISING QUIZ

1. Find a space or get online!

2. Spread the word

Let the students know about your quiz. Tell them when and where it is, what it's for and how much it will cost to take part.

3. Decide on an entry fee

Remember, all the cash you raise will go to help change people's lives. You could either charge individually or ask each team for a donation.

4. Have a prize!

Everyone loves winning, so offer a prize to reward your brainy students! If there's a draw, you could think up your own decider question.

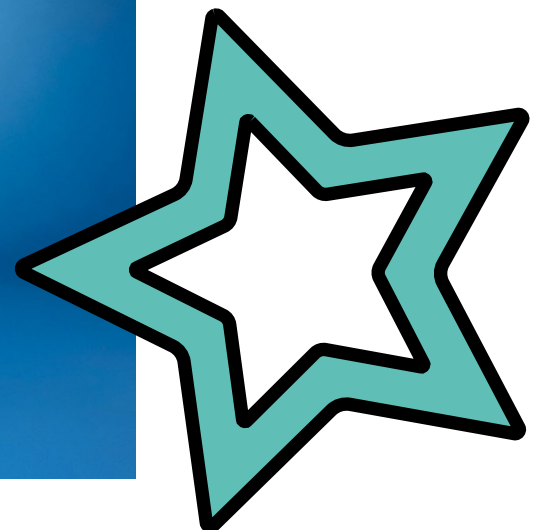

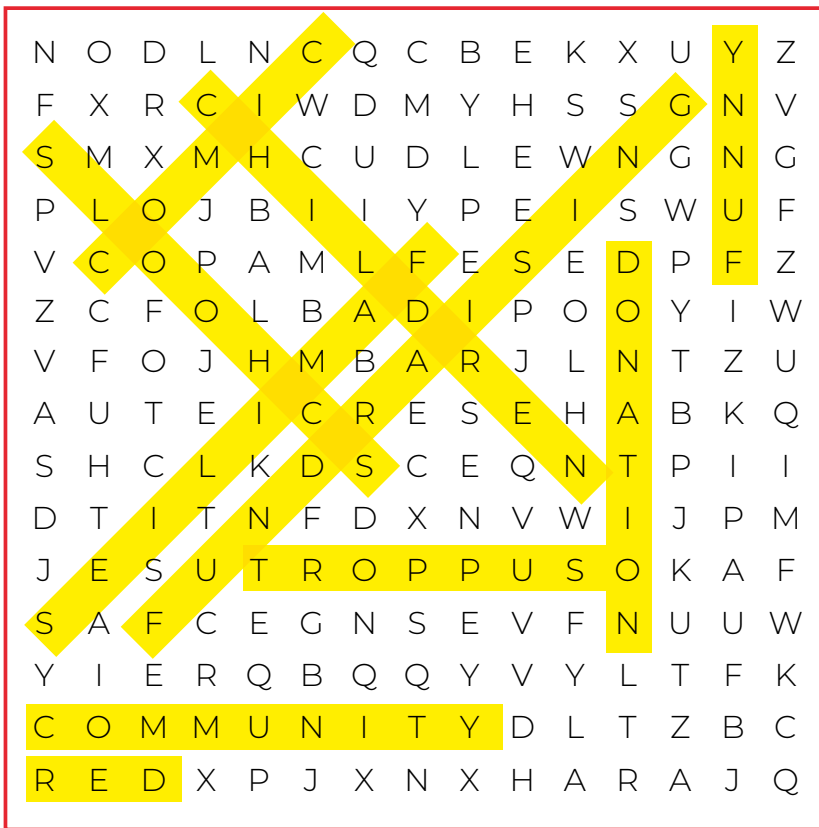
