## **Spread the word**

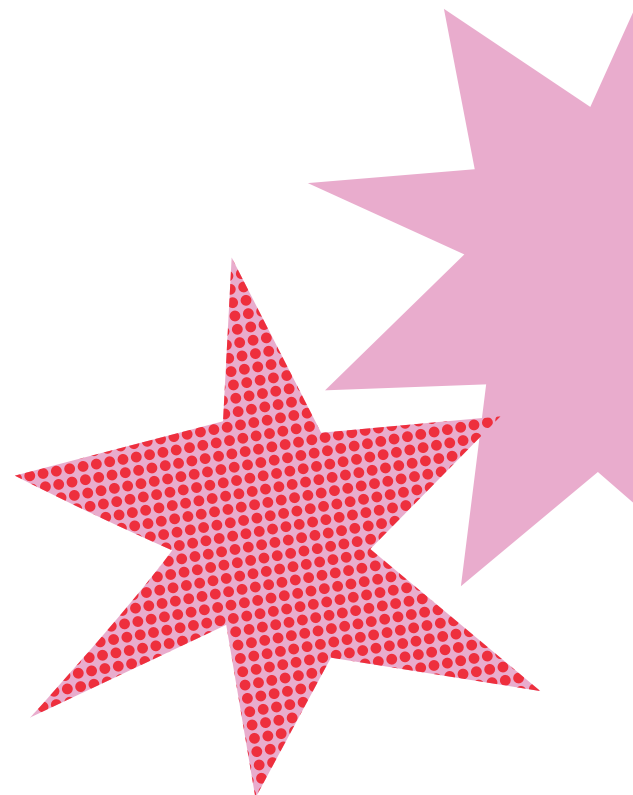
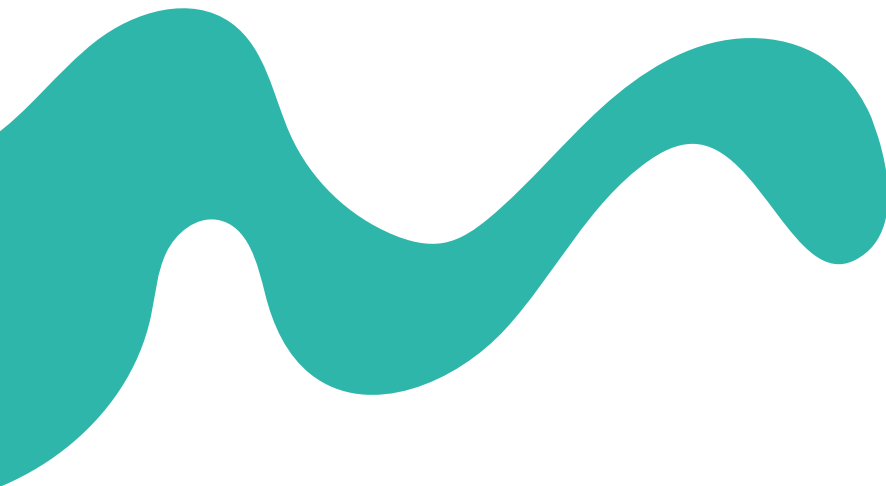
Let the students know about your quiz. Tell them when and where it is, what it's for, and how much it will cost to take part.
