



Savanna with Dot, Sky and Lucky



Dot the cheetah, Sky the giraffe and Lucky the lion live in a habitat known as Savanna, large open areas of grassland and scrub, typical in areas of Africa. These three animals live in very different ways but co-exist in this wonderful habitat. Let's find out more about them and their rich habitat.

Facts about savanna

- 1. Savanna covers around 65% of the African continent and around 20% of the planet's land areas.
- One of the most famous savanna habitats in the world is the Serengeti in Africa famous for its huge migration of wildebeest.
- 3. Savannas only have two seasons controlled by the amount of rainfall: wet and dry.



- Savanna habitats can easily transform into other habitat: a little more rain and they become forest; a little less rain and they turn into desert.
- 8. A lion's roar can be heard 5 miles away and female lions are the main hunters.
- Giraffes don't need much sleep each day with most sleeping between 10 minutes to two hours and they can grow up to 5.5 meters.
- 10. Cheetahs are super strong runners and climbers, they can go faster than most sports cars.

- Dot, Sky and Lucky share their habitat with loads of other animals including elephants, storks, warthogs, leopards, ostrich, rhino and zebra.
- 5. The habitat is split into three simple layers: tall grass, mixed grass and short grass with the tallest grass being elephant grass which can grow up to 10 feet tall.
- A common feature of animals found in savanna is long legs (and long wings) to help them travel long distances in search of water and food in times of drought.
