

### **KEY STAGE 1 ENGLISH ACTIVITIES**





#### Information for teachers

With Red Nose Day coming up on Friday 15 March, this booklet has been designed to help your class:

- engage with Red Nose Day
- understand why they are raising money
- develop their reading and writing skills.

There are six different activities for you to share with your pupils, based on the Red Nose Day story.

#### **Delivery guidance**

Give each pupil a copy of the sheet 'What is Red Nose Day?', or one between two if they are working in pairs. Read the information to the pupils and encourage them to follow as you read.

Check their understanding of any tricky words and ask questions to establish their recall, for example:

- How often does Red Nose Day happen?
- What year was the first Red Nose Day?
- Who can remember the date of this year's Red Nose Day?
- How do schools celebrate Red Nose Day?

Depending on the age and ability of your class, pick and choose from the worksheets in this booklet, differentiating for individuals and pairs to ensure that everyone can access activities.



#### **WHAT IS RED NOSE DAY?**




Red Nose Day is a special day when we raise money to help people in the UK and around the world. This year, Red Nose Day is on Friday 15 March.
