

# BINOCULARS CRAFT

## WITH SKY



If you're going to seek out opportunities for a scavenger hunt at any turn, you're going to need to keep an eye on the horizon at all times.

So, why not make your very own set of binoculars and be just like Sky?

### STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

#### ☐ Glue your loo rolls

Use the strongest glue you've got to make 3-5 glue-dots in a straight line down one edge of one loo roll, and then hold the other loo roll to it until it's stuck together. Be sure to wait for the glue to dry before continuing to the next step.

#### ☐ Wrap your rolls

This step is all about decoration. First, choose a paper to cover your rolls with. Then, add a little glue to your rolls before wrapping your paper around them. Carefully trim off the edges with your scissors to keep them nice and neat for exploring.

#### ☐ Bling your binos

No one adventurer is the same, so this step is all about putting your own stamp on your binoculars. Decorate them in a way that you think is awesome, with whatever materials you want to play with.

#### ☐ Measure and cut your string

Make it long enough that your binoculars can comfortably drape around your neck, and that you have enough to tie a knot each end. **\*Warning! don't leave children unattended**

#### ☐ Poke holes into the sides

Cut a small hole on the outside edge of each roll (about a centimetre from the top)

#### ☐ Tie on the string

Take one end of your string and thread it through the hole you made. Tie a knot to secure. Repeat with the other side of the string.

#### ☐ Go on your own adventure!



### YOU WILL NEED

- ☐ **One pair of scissors** (handled carefully at all times)
- ☐ **Two empty toilet paper rolls**
- ☐ **White glue**
- ☐ **Some string or ribbon**
- ☐ **Some thick card** (think Sugar Paper or Construction Paper)
- ☐ **Decorating supplies** (like markers, crayons, stickers, etc.) to make your binos unique
