What is Code Club?

Code Club is a global network of coding clubs where young people develop skills and confidence to become digital tech creators. It's part of the Raspberry Pi Foundation — a UK-based charity with the mission to enable young people to realise their full potential through the power of computing and digital technologies.

At Code Clubs, young people learn to code, build websites, create animations and games, and explore technology in an informal, creative, and social environment. They also have the opportunity to develop important life skills such as communication and critical thinking.

Young people at Code Clubs can also get involved in national and international showcases and events like Coolest Projects and the European Astro Pi Challenge.

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Do I have to attend with my child?

Yes, young people under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who is required to remain on the premises for the duration of the session. You will help your child to get set up and ready, then our mentors will support the young people in their learning.

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Should my child or I have prior coding knowledge?

No, Code Club is open to complete beginners as well as young people who have coded before. We have skilled mentors who will help with technical questions.
