How Code Club works

Code Club provides free coding projects with step-by-step instructions. The projects cover programming languages such as Scratch, HTML/CSS, and Python.

Code Club members use our projects to have fun creating games, animations, and websites while they learn key programming concepts. Code Clubs also help the young creators develop vital life skills such as collaboration, resilience, creativity, and problem-solving.

How you can help

You can volunteer alone or as part of a team at your local Code Club to:

- Support young creators during sessions. Don't worry if you have no coding experience, as all our project instructions are beginner-friendly. You just need to be enthusiastic about guiding young people to solve problems and willing to learn about coding alongside your Code Club members.
