Teréga's employees commit to climate action

As a committed actor in the energy transition, Teréga is mobilising all its employees around the topics emerging from the Climate Fresk workshop. The approach has proved popular within the company, with 250 workers already reached.

Teréga: committed workers

The Group's management decided to roll out the Climate Fresk approach across the whole workforce, to mobilise and increase their awareness of the climate challenges.

To help participants take ownership of the knowledge about climate change, Teréga decided on a fully in-house approach to running the workshops, training volunteers from among the workforce. So far, 18 facilitators are at work across Teréga's territories, running workshops within all the different departments.

Taking stock and taking action

The "Climate Fresk" collaborative workshop uses card games to mobilise the collective intelligence of the participants, helping them understand the essentials of the climate challenges so they can go on to take action. These events lead into discussions about the causes and consequences of climate change, but also about the actions the Group is taking to meet those challenges.

Teréga already has 250 "Fresked" workers, which is nearly one-third of the Group's total staff. The workshops will continue through to the end of 2023, allowing all employees to take part. Beyond 2023, they will continue for the benefit of new arrivals in the Group.

About Climate Fresk

Climate Fresk is a fun, interactive workshop. Based on collective intelligence, it helps improve understanding of climate change, its causes and consequences, and thus significantly speed up individual and collective awareness of its challenges. The tool was created in 2015 by Cédric Ringenbach, founder of the Climate Fresk association, and more than 700,000 people across 50 different countries have benefited from its awareness-raising work. The data used comes from reports written by international researchers from the IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change).

The workshop begins with an opportunity to think: participants work together to link up 42 cards that illustrate the causes and consequences of climate disruption. They work through the climate challenges in their entirety.
