To make renewable gas an accelerator of the energy transition, Teréga is taking part in the Assises du Produire en France and the Made in France Nouvelle-Aquitaine trade fair

In 10 years, the Made in France trade fair has become an unmissable event, and this year it is heading off into the regions, with Nouvelle-Aquitaine as its starting point. As a partner of the event taking place this weekend in Bordeaux, Teréga can use it to showcase its industrial expertise, its environmental innovations, and its contribution to the economic expansion of territories in the South West. The fair will take place at the same time and in the same place as the 5th Assises du Produire en France, where eight presidential election candidates are expected to take part in a major debate about French reindustrialisation and manufacturing.

Teréga is a partner of the MIF Nouvelle Aquitaine trade fair, taking place from 11 to 13 March at the Palais des Congrès in Bordeaux.

Since 2012, the Made in France trade fair has provided a shop window for French industry and its innovations, but it has also been the ideal setting for meetings between economic stakeholders in the region, the general public, journalists and politicians.

This first territory-based event, with free entry for all, will also provide an opportunity for 10,000

visitors to come and meet a hundred or so businesses, including Teréga, and to discover the advantages of a major territorial stakeholder in the energy sector, which for 75 years has deployed its exceptional expertise in developing and operating gas transport and storage infrastructures.

Teréga will turn the spotlight on its support for green gases, such as the development of methanisation, the roll-out of the hydrogen industry, and the multi-energy and digital services developed by its subsidiary, Teréga Solutions, to maximise energy efficiency. Produced locally by the repurposing of waste, methanisation actually helps build a renewable, decentralised energy mix, at the same time encouraging the economic development of the territories. The refinement of hydrogen solutions, powerful tools for greening certain industries which are hard to decarbonise, will also become a factor in greater competitiveness and significant economic dynamism in the local industrial fabric.
