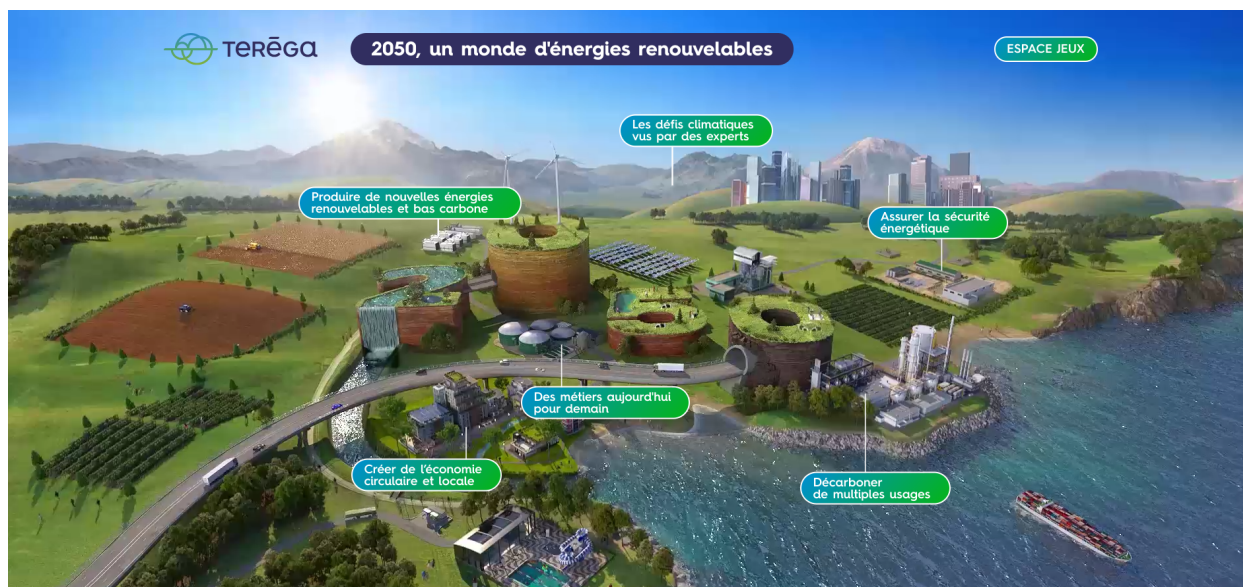

  - **11 am to 12:30 pm**, a "Long live your town" live programme: 90 minutes to showcase local entrepreneurs and the lifeblood of our regions. Broadcast available on YouTube and Twitter
  - **2 pm**: the village will open to the public, offering fun activities, demonstrations, and quizzes on future challenges such as energy, the sorting of waste and the discovery of biosourced matter, within areas devoted to industry, innovation, climate and employment. **8 pm to 11 pm**, concerts by a number of different artists
- **Summer tour (29/04-20/09):** the "Long live your town" programme will take place from **3 pm to 5 pm**, leaving the village open to the public until the evening when everyone will be able to attend the concerts organised throughout the tour
