Jérémy Perrot has been Manager of Strategy and Innovation at Teréga SA since 2017 and, in this capacity, was a member of the Extended Executive Committee. He joined the company in May 2012 as Storage and Compression Development Engineer before being appointed Strategic Studies Manager at the end of 2013.

A graduate of the Ecole Polytechnique de Paris and the École Nationale Supérieure de l'Aéronautique et de l'Espace in Toulouse, Jérémy Perrot began his career in 2004 at Schlumberger, the world leader in oilfield services. Within the *Well Testing Services* division, he successively worked as a field engineer on international sites (2004-2006) then as a well testing supervisor in Algeria for oil majors operating in the Maghreb (2006-2007). Subsequently, within the *Carbon Services* division, which he joined in 2007, he worked as a well engineer and assistant project manager before being appointed two years later as project manager leading a multinational team of experts on European CO2 capture and storage projects.

His appointment marks a new stage in the implementation of the projects conducted within the Strategy and Innovation division that he managed. His extensive knowledge of the energy sector and engineering fields means that Jérémy Perrot's mission will be to accelerate the growth of Teréga Solutions' activities in the methanisation sector as locally as possible in the regions.

The creation of this new Business Unit is therefore in line with the successful equity investments made in 2020 in the start-up company [DualMétha](#) and the [Chadasaygas Group](#). These mergers demonstrate Teréga's active commitment to promoting renewable energies and projects serving the regions of tomorrow.
