Teréga and Bpifrance: actively backing youth employment at the Teréga Open Pau-Pyrénées

Teréga and Bpifrance are actors committed to the development of the territories, and particularly active on the challenges of employment and recruitment. They are holding an event on 2 March to help the businesses and young people of the Béarn area come together. The programme includes pitches from company managers, dedicated youth coaching workshops led by top-level sportsmen and women, and a job meeting. The gathering, organised against the backdrop of the Teréga Open Pau-Pyrénées (TOPP), will combine the dynamism and values of the sporting world with those of business.

Teréga: committed to young people in its territory

As an operator working to help the Béarn area achieve its economic potential, Teréga is committed to encouraging opportunities for local businesses and the rich reservoir of young talent in the territory to meet and move forward together. Mobilising its partners around this event during the tournament is an opportunity to combine effectiveness with entertainment, underpinned by the dynamism inherent in the world of sport.

The Teréga Open Pau-Pyrénées provides a backdrop for valuable meetings between all economic actors in the region, and boosts the vitality and profile of the territories of the South West.

This is the second year in a row that Bpifrance is taking part in this major sporting event for the territory, alongside Teréga, mobilising its communities: the "Les Excellence" business club, which brings together 6000 growing businesses in France (of which Teréga is a member), "Les Meneurs", consisting of 53 partner professional sporting Clubs (including Section Paloise), its future higher education community, and all regional actors involved in economic and social development.

Innovation for employment



These gatherings are being held over a half-day on the fringes the tournament on **Thursday 2 March** from **1.30 to 5pm**, drawing a hundred young people from the territory. As an actor committed to businesses, Bpifrance has worked with Teréga and the tournament management to put together a programme combining speeches from managers, coaching and job meetings.

Programme for the afternoon:

- 2pm Brief welcome by Sofia Djaadaoui of Bpifrance (Operations Manager representing Julien Noronha, Executive Director of Communication at Bpifrance), Dominique Mockly (Chairman and CEO of Teréga), and Jérémy Chardy (Director of Teréga Open Pau-Pyrénées) / Round table discussion on youth employment led by Sofia Djaadaoui with contributions from Dominique Mockly, Patrice Begay (Executive Vice President of communication, development and marketing at the Talan group), Jérémy Chardy, and Bernard Pontneau (Chairman of Section Paloise).
- 2.30pm "**PITCH YOUR BIZ!**": over the space of 30 minutes, 15 companies from the Bpifrance Les Excellence club involved in the Béarn territory take turns to present their expertise and persuade young talents to join them.
- 3pm "COACH YOUR YOUTH": Young people will benefit from a special coaching session delivered by high-level sportsmen and women and by personalities from the region's sporting scene, whose high demands and excellence are the mark of their success. The session will be led by Jérémy Chardy, Tournament Director, accompanied by tennis player Nicola Escudé (17th in the ATP 2000 rankings), Former French rugby international Julien Pierre, Audrey Sauret (Managing Director of Elan Béarnais), Bernard Pontneau (Chairman of Section Paloise), and Sébastien Piqueronies and Fabrice Metz (one the Manager and the other a player from Section Paloise). Cyclists Elisabeth Chevanne Brunel and Marion Clignet, the founders of the CIC International Women's Tour of the Pyrenees, will also be part of the coaching team.
- 3.45pm "GOOD JOB!": a job meeting where business leaders and young people from the territory can discuss their needs and expectations, and seize upon some good opportunities for working together.
