Winter 2026-2027: Teréga has concluded its gas storage auction campaign

This Wednesday, January 28, Teréga, the historical operator of gas transport and storage infrastructures in the South-West, concluded its marketing campaign for its storage capacities for the period April 2026 - March 2027. Teréga's storage represents 26% of French capacities. The two underground reservoirs of Lussagnet (Landes) and Izaute (Gers) help ensure the country's energy supply security, and their geographical position gives them a major role at the crossroads of South European gas exchanges.

34,000 GWh of Storage Subscribed

The marketing of Teréga's storage capacities for the year 2026-27 spanned from November 2022 until January 28, 2026, following the **auctions** organized on its Storeplace platform. During these auctions, **4 different storage products** were offered to the market to meet all needs:

- **FIZZ** (withdrawal over 85 days): 22,200 GWh;
- **FAIR** (withdrawal over 110 days): 9,300 GWh;
- **FAST** (withdrawal over 40 days): 1,600 GWh;
- **OPSTOCK** (withdrawal over 55 days): 900 GWh.

Out of the **44 companies** that participated in the auctions, **37 are now customers** for the 2026-27 storage year.

Market conditions deteriorated starting at the beginning of 2026, due to the inversion of price differentials between summer and winter (summer prices higher than winter prices). Nevertheless, Teréga managed to conclude its marketing with the full subscription of its **34 TWh of working gas volume associated with 581 GWh/day of withdrawal rate.**

With an **average selling price of €1.01/MWh**, the revenues generated by the 2026-27 campaign reached **€34.5 million.**

Teréga also organized **multi-year auctions** during this campaign, allowing its customers to have the same storage capacities for 2 or 3 consecutive years.

As of today, **Teréga has already marketed 46% of its capacities for the year 2027-28 and 12% for 2028-29.**

Today, it continues to develop innovative solutions to overcome the major energy challenges facing France and Europe.
