## Japan Society 2022 Annual Dinner Frequently Asked Questions

### **Will the Annual Dinner take place in person this year? What is the format?**

Yes, we are planning to hold the 2022 Annual Dinner in person, for the first time in three years. The format will be the same as pre-Covid Annual Dinners (standing receptions followed by a seated dinner). However, should federal, state, city or CDC regulations or recommendations dictate, the event may be held as a hybrid or fully-virtual event.

### **How much of my contribution is tax-deductible?**

Amounts in excess of \$2,800 per table or \$280 per ticket is tax-deductible.

### **How many guests will be seated at each table?**

There are 10 seats per table.

### **Should our guests RSVP to Japan Society directly?**

No, please have your guests notify you if they are attending, then send the list of guests to Japan Society using the template we have provided.

### **Will this event be socially distanced?**

No. This event will be at full capacity.

### **Do guests need to be vaccinated?**

Full vaccination and booster (if eligible) are required in order to attend this event. Proof of vaccination and ID will be checked at the doors. Digital photos or app copies of vaccination proof are acceptable.

### **Do guests need to take a test?**

We are requesting that all attendees take a test the day of the event. Rapid/home tests are acceptable. Guests are not required to show proof of negative test at the door.

### **Will guests need to wear a mask?**

Masks are strongly encouraged when not actively eating or drinking.
