

Ludwigsburg Residential Palace
In 1704, Duke Eberhard Ludwig of Württemberg began building a hunting lodge, which became Ludwigsburg Palace, Germany's largest Baroque residence.

Weikersheim Palace and Garden
Weikersheim Palace, in northern Baden-Württemberg, is a well-preserved Renaissance palace known for its elegant gardens, ornate interiors, and historic charm.

Castle Hohenzollern
With battlements and towers, this 19th-century Neo-Gothic castle looks like a storybook fortress, standing on a site with a 1,000-year history.

Hohenzollern Palace Sigmaringen
Perched above the Danube, Hohenzollern Palace evolved from a fortress into a royal palace with fairytale towers, 60 miles south of Stuttgart.

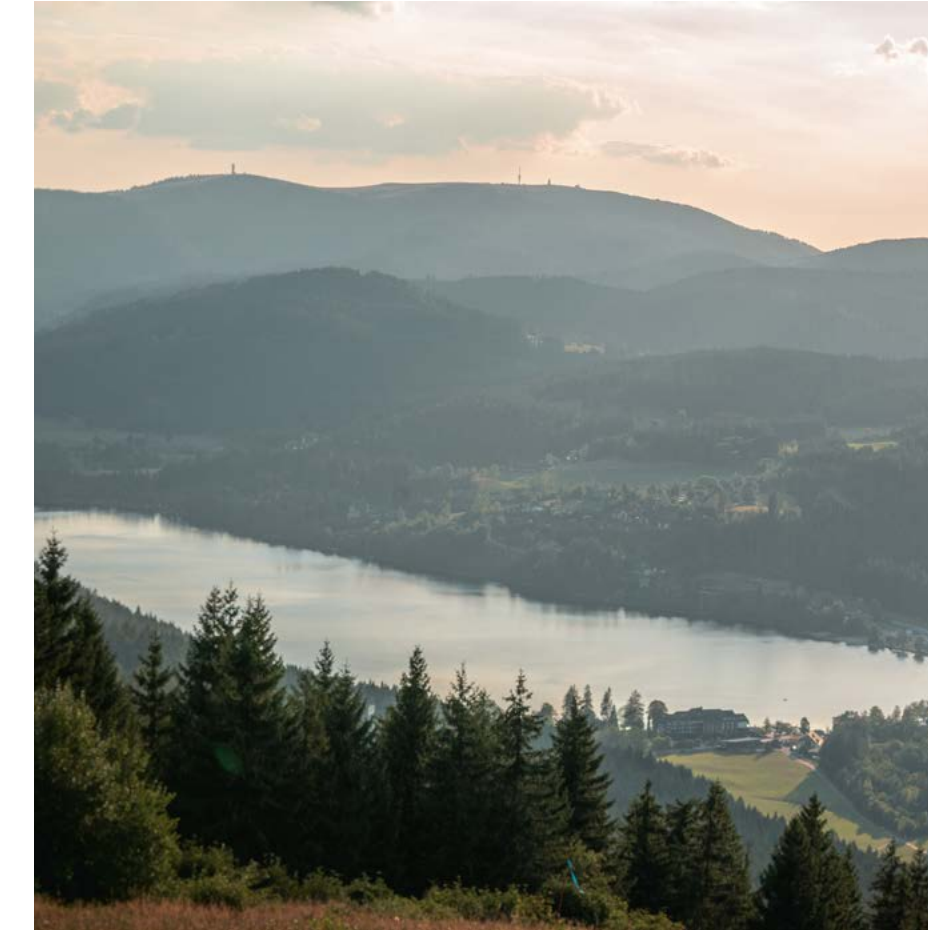
Tripsdrill Theme Park
